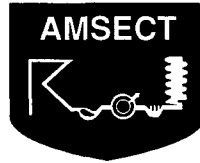


From the Editor



Dear Reader,

I want to be sure that you are aware the Journal of Extra-Corporeal Technology is indexed in the Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature (CINAHL). This indexing service was started by three hospital librarians in 1961 as the Cumulative Index to Nursing Literature. It was later expanded to include periodicals from other medical disciplines. Today CINAHL indexes over 330 nursing, allied health and biomedical journals.

CINAHL is published six times a year and is also available as an on-line database. Materials are indexed using CINAHL's Subject Heading List, which is based on the National Library of Medicine's Medical Subject Headings (MeSH).

I hope you will find CINAHL to be a useful tool for accessing information that has been published in the Journal. If you need more information about this valuable service, contact your medical librarian or communicate directly with CINAHL at (818) 409-8005.
